- The European Muay Confederation presents the 7th EUROPEAN MUAY CHAMPIONSHIP 2018, hosted and organized in Cluj Napoca, Romania. The event will represent the stress test for each and every team, athlete and federation of their work, training and techniques against teams from all over the world. This event will be a great chance to evaluate athletes, referees and coaches performances. The aim of the Organizers is to create a standardize environment where all teams could evaluate their level and proficiency.
- The event will create a platform where different cultures from all over the world could meet and experience the best that the Muay Sport has to offer. Also the event offers a unique opportunity for members from over the world to enjoy experience and interact with the beautiful traditions and culture of the host country and among themselves respectively.

Rules and regulation:

The Rules and regulation of the competition are in accordance with the statues of the European Muay Confederation and its Rule Book for Amateur Events:

- As per the regulation mention in the statues each National Federation/National Representative will bring one athlete for each weight category only.
- Each National Delegation must bring **ONE REFEREE/JUDGE** with them for every 1 4 athletes.
- All athletes will have to present International Medical Insurance.
- The head of delegation for each National Team will be responsible for their team members and also to have all documents in order as required.

Fee

- Registration fee competition: 30 Euro (for everyone attending the Event (Including Officials Athletes & Guests)
- Annual Membership fee EMC 2018 /2019 : 200 Euro



The Amateur category will award the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place with: medal and certificates.

The Host City of the Competition

This western city in the region of Transylvania traces its origins back to the Dacian settlement of Napuca in the 2-nd century A.D. After the Roman take-over of Dacia, it was renamed Napoca and in 124 A.D., received the rank of "municipium". The city quickly advanced socially and economically and during Marcus Aurelius' reign Napoca received the title "colonia", the highest possible urban status in the Roman Empire.

With one of the most vibrant economies in the country and a population of around 330,000, Cluj, is today a vibrant cultural and educational city. The six state and several private universities located here also make Cluj Napoca the city with the largest percentage of student

population in Romania.













Accommodation

The official hotel for the European Muay Championship it is Belvedere Hotel, a 3* HOTEL in Cluj – Napoca, Romania. Set on Cetatuia (Fortress) Hill, overlooking Cluj-Napoca, this property offers free access to the sauna, gym and indoor pool. Unirea Square and the Old City center, located in the heart of the city, is 1.2 km from here. Cluj-Napoca International Airport is at 9 km from this property.
